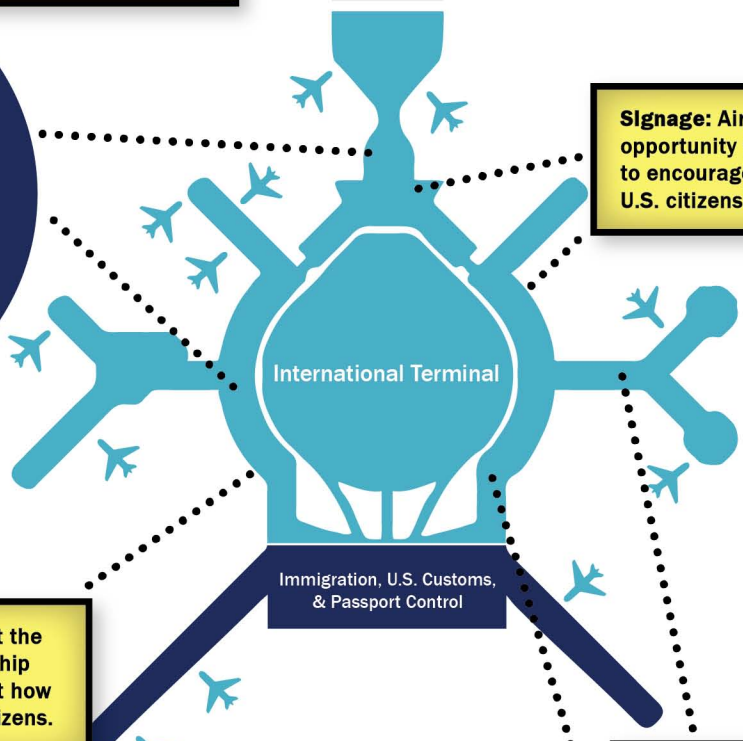
Have you thought about becoming a U.S. citizen? If you have been a permanent resident for more than 5 years, you may be eligible to naturalize.
